CONGRATULATIONS

The years of hard work at high school are about to pay off with the joy of graduating and earning your high school diploma. Here at Redstone College, we understand that enrolling in college is a big commitment, so we've developed some programs intended to recognize motivated high school seniors like you and to encourage your pursuit of career-focused higher education in the field of your choice.

The scholarships will contribute directly to the tuition for the program selected by the recipient.

High School Scholarship Programs

There are two high school scholarship categories and one award.

President's Scholarship

The award amount includes full tuition, fees and books. There is one President's Scholarship available at Redstone College.*

Dean's Scholarships

The award amount is \$5,000 for an associate degree program and \$2,500 for a diploma program. The scholarships are offered in Avionics (AVI), Airframe and Powerplant (A & P), Wind Energy Technology (WIND), and HVAC. There are two scholarships per program available.

Preparation for Success Award

An award of \$1,000 toward a degree or \$500 toward a diploma.

Terms and Conditions for the Preparation for Success Award and Scholarships

- Must be a 2015 high school senior.
- Must be enrolled in a Redstone College degree or diploma program during the 2015 school year.
- Must be attending a Redstone school. Current employee waivers and online programs are not eligible.
- Must meet the following admissions requirements to Redstone College: complete a campus tour and complete a strong start meeting.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

1. Eligibility—The student must meet all of the requirements for the Preparation for Success Award by the scholarship submission deadline.
2. Scholarship application—All information requested on the application must be complete and legible. The application must be signed by the applicant and an email address is required for notification of receipt.
3. High school transcript—The most current available transcript at the time of application must be submitted and must state the cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA). The scholarships require a GPA of 2.0.
4. Letter of intent—As introduced to the student by his/her admissions representative at the time of application.
5. Personal essay—A 250-word essay must be submitted legibly and written in ink or typewritten by the applicant, explaining reasons for pursuing career-focused higher education in his/her program of choice at Redstone College.

Scholarship Application Submission Procedure

All materials and supplementary documents must be submitted together in one envelope. Incomplete application packets will not be accepted. The envelope must be received by Scholarship Administration on or before the submission deadline. See reverse side for mailing address.

Submissions deadline: July 15, 2015 Award date: August 1, 2015

Redstone Scholarship Distribution

- For a student to be eligible for any of the Redstone scholarship disbursements he/she must complete at least 60% of the term of study with a GPA of 2.5 or higher for each term of disbursement
- If a student withdraws after the 60% time frame, he/she will receive a pro-rated amount of the scholarship based on the percentage of tuition charged pursuant to the refund policy outlined in the college catalog.
- Maximum disbursement is as follows:
 - Preparation for Success Award: Maximum disbursement of \$143 per term.
 - Dean's Scholarship: Equal disbursement of \$715 per term.
 - President's Scholarship: Funds will be distributed equally up to the current tuition and fees charged per academic term.

* President's Scholarship recipients are not eligible for the Dean's scholarships, Preparation for Success Award or the Imagine America Scholarship. GEDs do not qualify.
